

### Refund Policy and Program Withdrawal:

The tuition deposit must be paid prior to receiving the I-20. This tuition deposit will be applied to the student's tuition when they arrive and enroll in the program. The remainder of the program fee must be paid by the Friday of orientation week. The tuition deposit is non-refundable unless the student does not obtain a visa. Proof of visa denial in the form of a denial letter from the U.S. embassy or consulate is required to be eligible for a refund. TCALC will retain the tuition deposit for those students who defer their application to a future session.

Students who withdraw after enrolling in our program will follow our program withdrawal refund policy below. The withdrawal refund policy applies to all TCALC programs. When a student withdraws during the first week of classes, refunds are made only on the tuition paid not including the tuition deposit and student fees.

Before the 1 <sup>st</sup> day of classes	100% of total program fee paid (minus application fee and tuition deposit)
Before the Friday of the 1 <sup>st</sup> week of classes	75% of tuition paid only (minus application fee, tuition deposit, and non-tuition student fees)
After the 1 <sup>st</sup> week of classes	0%
